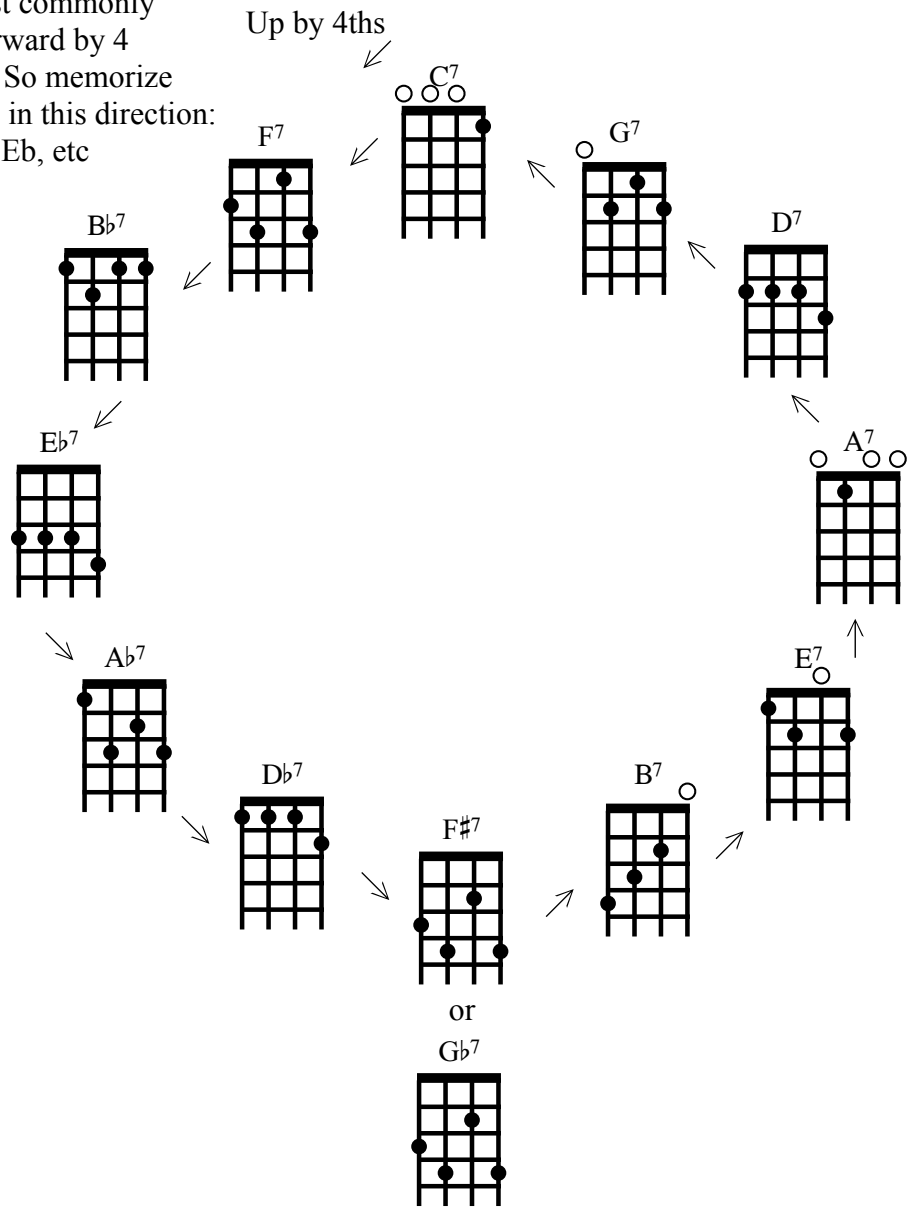

# Chords Following the Cycle of 4ths

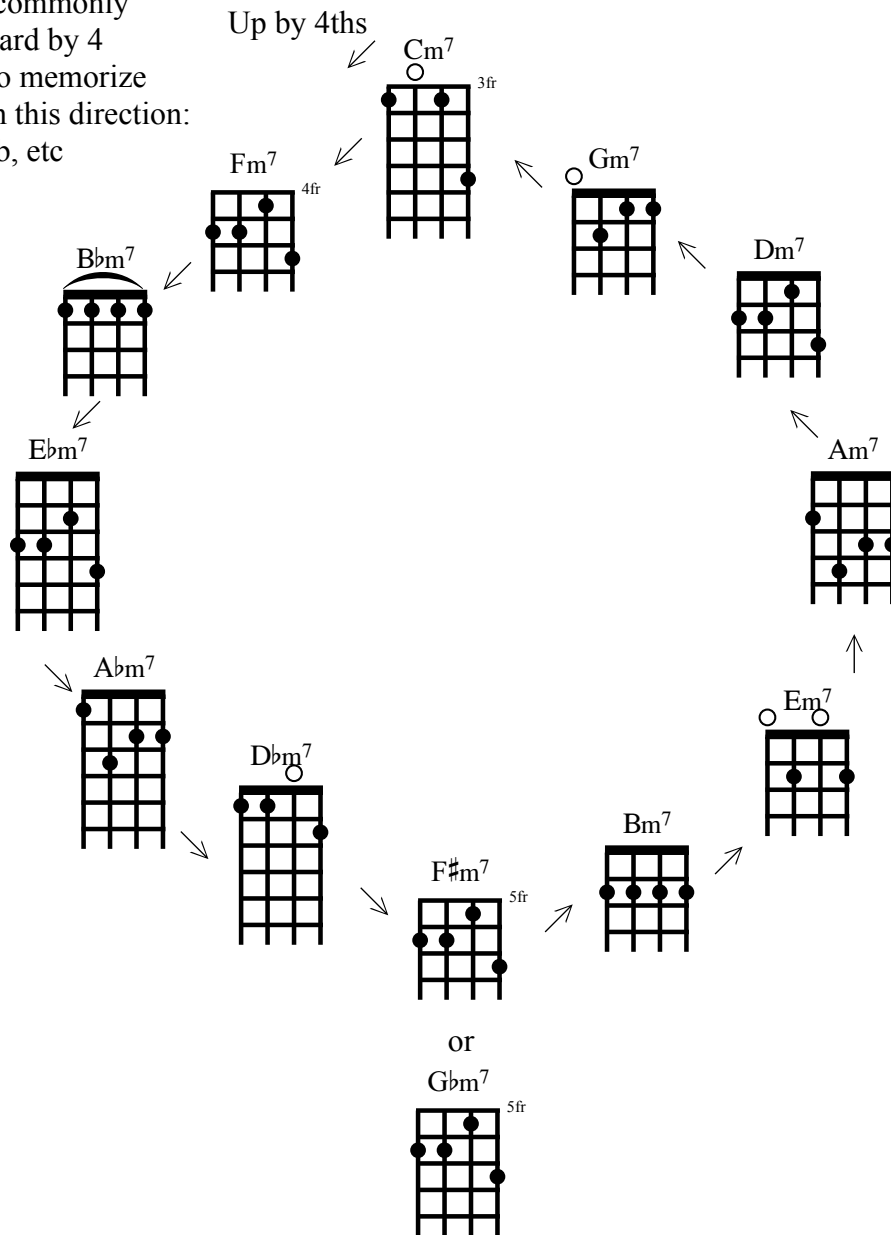
## DOMINANT 7TH CHORDS

Chords most commonly progress forward by 4 scale tones. So memorize your chords in this direction: ie C, F, Bb, Eb, etc



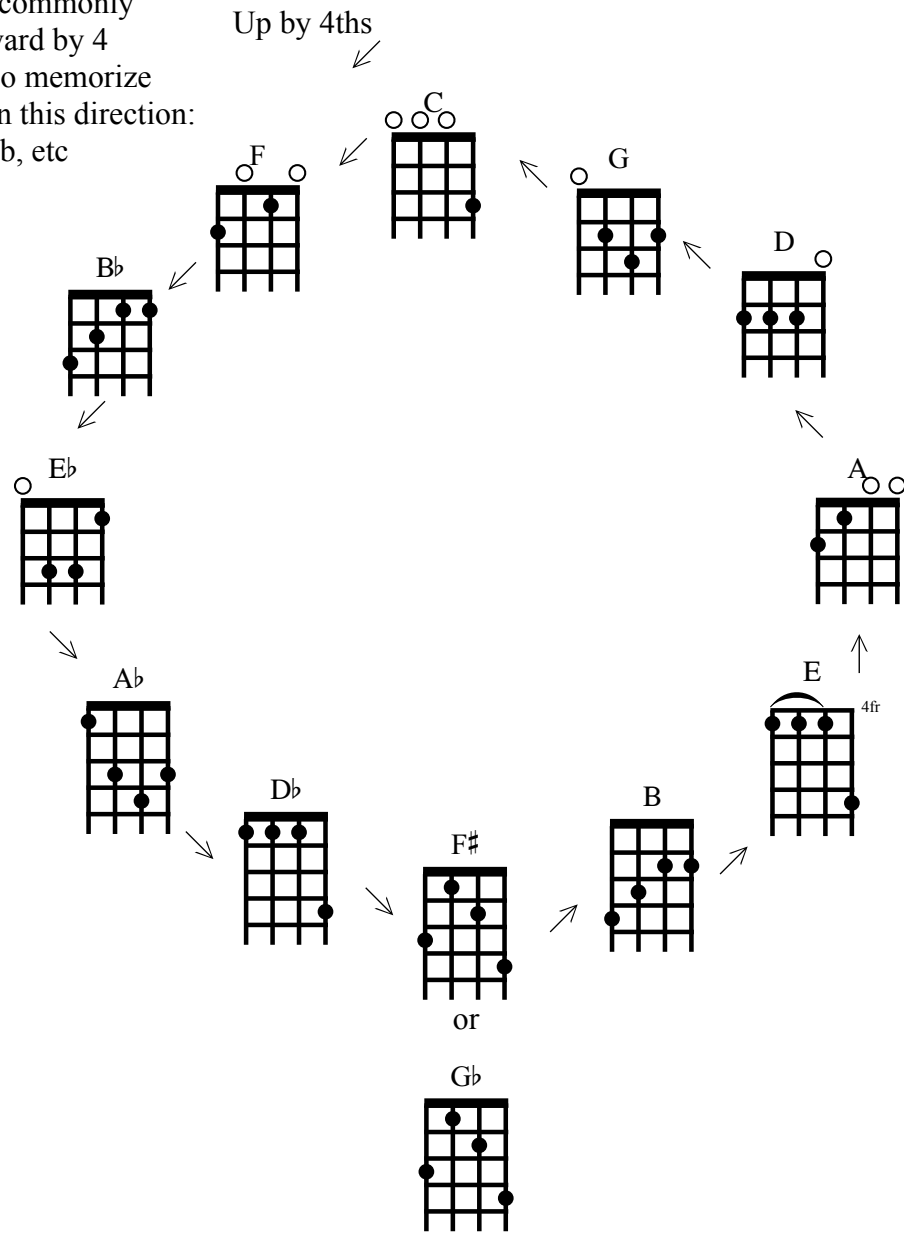
### MINOR 7TH CHORDS

Chords most commonly progress forward by 4 scale tones. So memorize your chords in this direction: ie C, F, Bb, Eb, etc



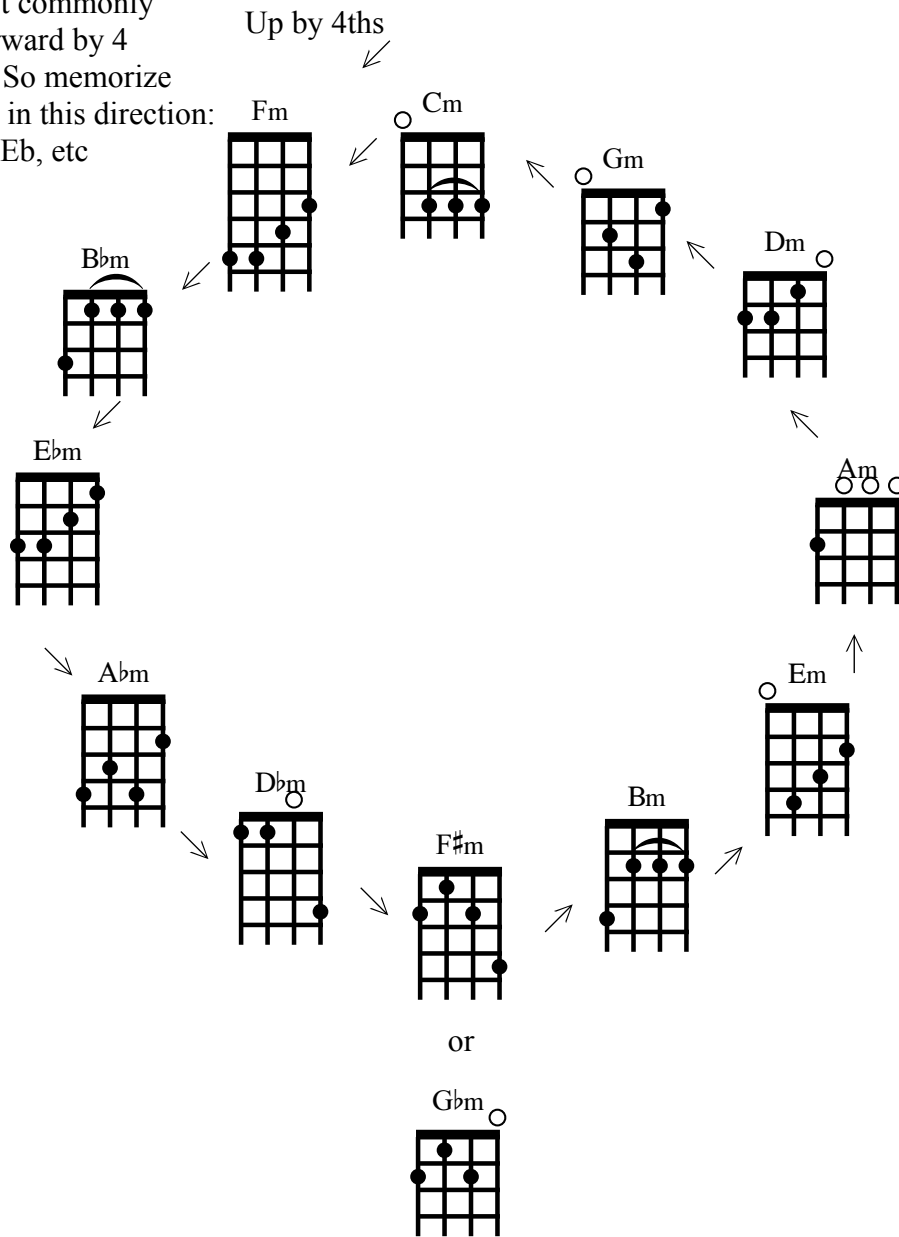
**MAJOR CHORDS (triads)**
